**\$165.00 per week**

Day camp, with weekly Time Machine themes, includes camp T-shirt, tote bag, all materials, morning and afternoon snacks, well-balanced lunch, recreational swimming, and field trips\*.

**Specialty Camp: 9:00 AM - 3:30 PM**

**\$200.00 per week**

Specialty camp includes all materials, morning and afternoon snacks, well-balanced lunch, and daily recreational swimming. Additional fees may be required for some specialty camps\*.

**Extended Day Camp: 6:30 AM - 6:30 PM**

**\$195.00 per week**

**Extended Specialty Camp: 6:30 AM - 6:30 PM**

**\$230.00 per week**

Campers needing care before 9 AM and after 3:30 PM participate in our Before and After Care program in addition to Day Camp or Specialty Camp.

Families with two children enrolled receive a 10% discount on the lower tuition of the two children. Families with three or more children enrolled receive a 10% discount on the total family tuition.
